In Maths this week we have been looking at prime numbers, prime factors, square and cube numbers. We can now identify many properties of a number e.g. 64 is a square number, a cube number, its prime factors can be written as $2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2$ or 2^6 and it has 7 factors.

We have been continuing our building of 'Arctic' vehicles using Lego Wedo and will begin writing persuasive adverts/promotional materials for them next week.



On Monday morning, as part of our Year of Computing, we will be having a STEM workshop which links our Science learning of forces with Computing, using Meccano to build and program vehicles.
