RE: Why do some people believe that God exists? Values of Jesus

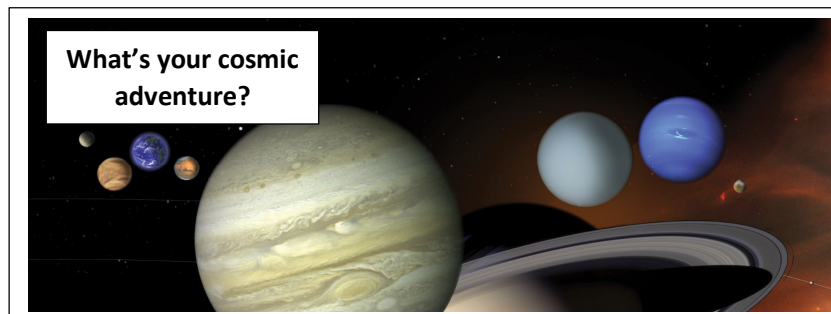
RSE – Is it ever okay to break a secret?
