

Class: Pearl Date of project: Terms 5 and 6

Children will be immersed in the world of Harry Potter, magic and Hogwarts. They will look at the various 'Fantastic Beasts' in the wizarding world and will create their own. In art, children will use watercolours to paint their magical creatures before developing a lino print tile and overprinting using more than one colour.

After reading Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, children will work in their house groups to produce a film trailer. They will develop scripts, make props and plan and film scenes in front of a green screen before editing and promoting their films.

Maths - Geometry (angles and translation), Measures (area, perimeter, time)

Science – Earth and Space; Animals including humans.

History/Geography – Aztecs – who were they and where did they live?

PE – Athletics (units 1 & 2), Quidditch and Outdoor Adventurous Activities.


French – En classe (In the classroom)
