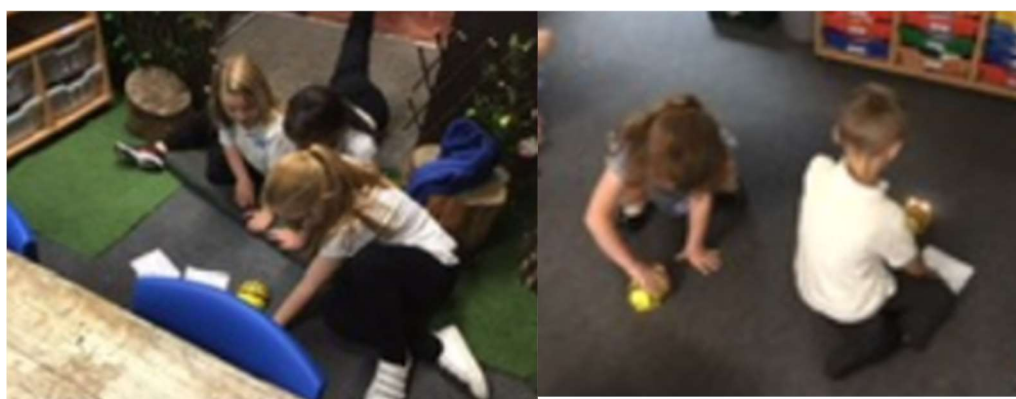


Ruby Class News
