Things to note:

I have had a lovely time teaching in Ruby class the last few weeks and look forward to seeing the children around school next term. There is an inset day on Tuesday 2nd January and school will reopen on Wednesday 3rd January 2024.

For spellings, we have sent home a sheet of new phonics sounds that the children have been learning this term. There are some words using those sounds on the back for the children to practise.

This week:

In English, we started to learn about when to use exclamation marks and the children wrote some fantastic exclamation sentences. They then wrote a postcard in the role of the snail from our class story. When writing their postcards, the children focussed on using 'er' and 'est' suffixes. In Maths, we continued to learn about shapes and their properties and sorting 2D and 3D shapes.

It was lovely to see the children dresses up on Tuesday. They had a busy day doing a range of activities including building a pirate den or mermaid cave. The children used great teamwork skills to do this using the playpod equipment. It was lovely to see how creative they were and how they solved problems by working together.
