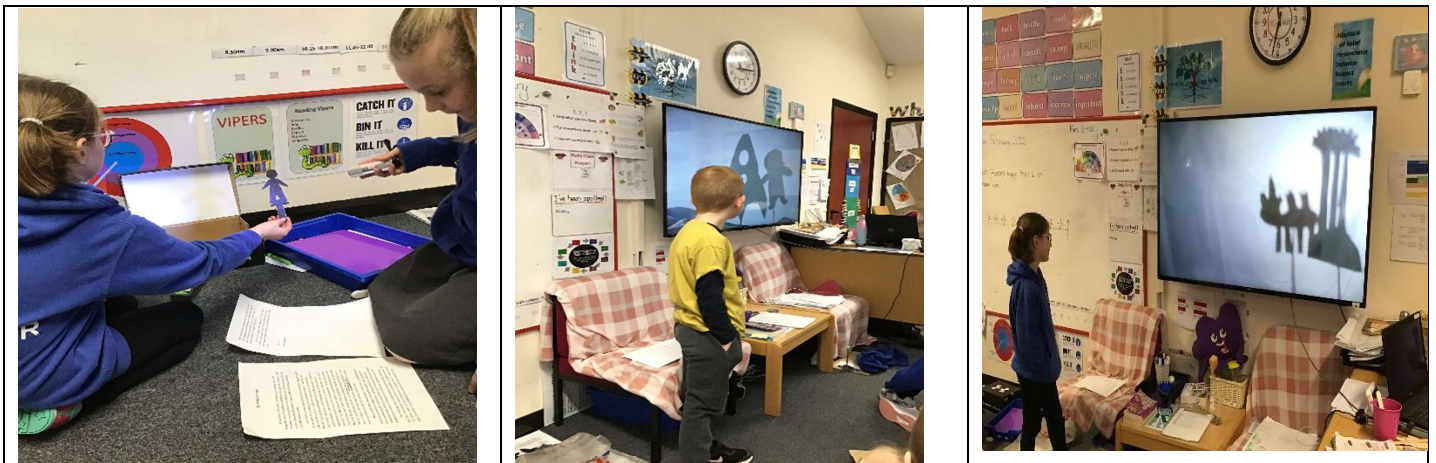


Ruby Class Newsletter
