In **English** this week we have been recapping our knowledge about sequencing words to order the events in our key text, *Toys in Space*. The children have been retelling the events and have written short recounts using their sentence writing skills.

In **Maths** we have continued our learning about 3d shapes; naming them, counting and describing faces, vertices and edges. The children have enjoyed some practical shape investigations rolling them down tubes to check their properties and printing the shape faces in paint. Mathematics will be set on Thursday to be completed by the following Thursday (Starting yesterday, Thurs 18th).

In **Science** we have been learning about materials, with the children naming and describing simple properties of materials such as metal, wood, glass, plastic, fabric. In **Geography** we have started learning about the countries of the UK and the capital cities. This week we have been looking at England and London. In **Art** we have been continuing with printing. The children have made repeating and overlapping prints this week. Our art learning this term will lead us to our first mini outcome for our project.
