Ruby Class Newsletter

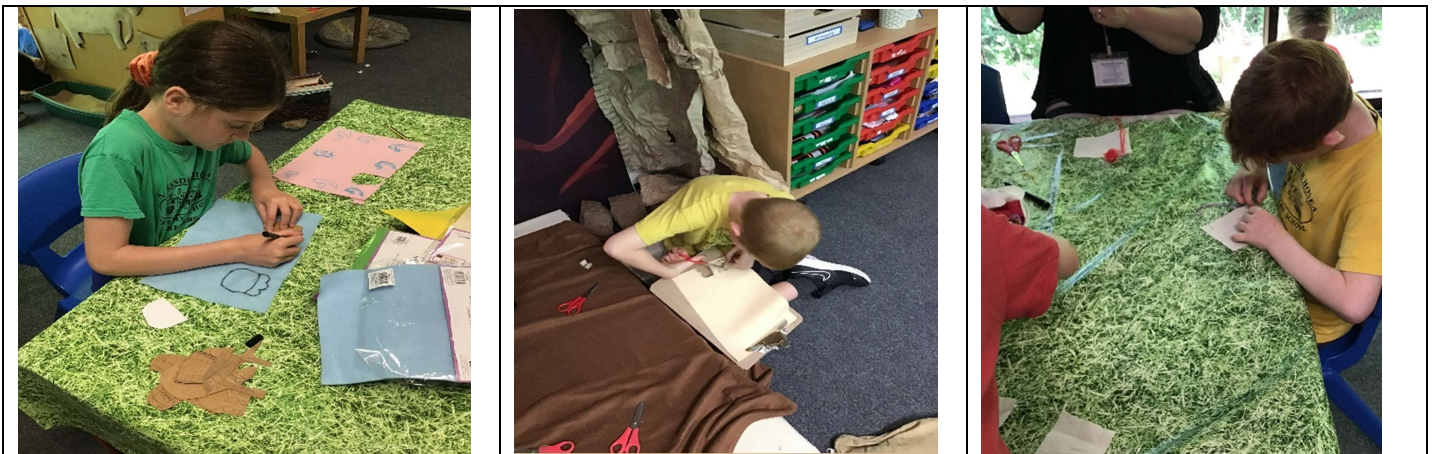
Lots of difficult learning this week, but once again all the children persevered and amazed me! In maths, the children have begun telling the time to 5 minute and 1 minute intervals. We have found this really tricky, however, with constant practice I am sure the children will succeed.

During English, the children have been looking at and researching instructions for different things to do with the Stone Age. Next week, they will create their own instructions from the ideas they have come up with!

In science, as the children have become superb scientists, it was time for them to predict what materials would be magnetic, and which that were not. After this, the children were then able to conduct their experiment to see if their predictions were correct.

In Jigsaw, the children were thinking about top tips to stay safe online. I was really pleased to hear them be so mature and recall things they learned on Safer Internet day.

During art this week, I had some fantastic parent helpers (thank you!) who helped the children during their sewing. The children remembered how to do a running stitch and therefore some of them created shapes! While this was going on, other children were creating designs on felt to cut out - these will be sewn onto bags next week.



In PE, the children used the new track to practice for sports day. We did sprint, skipping, egg and spoon and sack race! The children really enjoyed this and will be practicing with Emerald class as a pre sports day warm up.

In computing this term, the children have been using Scratch to create algorithms. This week, the children took that knowledge and wrote the algorithm into their books - they were able to see the similarities and differences between Scratch and Probots.
