Phonics

This week we have been looking at contractions. The children have practised reading and writing words with apostrophes such as didn't, you'll, we're. We have been noticing that the apostrophe goes where there are letters missing from the words that have been contracted rather than where the words join. It would be helpful if you could keep a look out for any contracted words in children's reading books and talk about which words have been contracted and which letters are missing. For example, I'll = I will and the w and i have been replaced by an apostrophe.

Next week we will start phase 5 of our phonics scheme where we will begin to learn alternative pronunciations for graphemes that have already been met and alternative spellings for phonemes. We will also begin to learn some new common exception words. After half term we will introduce new spelling books so you will be able to practise these new phonemes, graphemes and common exception words at home.
