In maths, we have recapped our knowledge of multiplication and division. The children have looked at recalling multiplication and division facts for the 3s, 4s and 8s times table and have explored related facts (Fact Families). We have also started to look at addition, focusing on adding 1-digit and multiples of 10 to a 3-digit number.



In English, we have completed our newspaper reports and are typing part of them up in computing. We have also learnt about writing simple and compound sentences. Then practised applying this new skill into our writing by completing a short narrative about George's Marvellous Medicine.



In science this week, we have explored the different parts of a plant. This has linked to our history where we have started to research Edward Jenner and how he used plants in his medicines. In history, we imagined Edward Jenner had come to visit and we asked him questions about his life. In PSHE, we have thought about what it might be like to be a new child in our school. In music, we continued to learn songs with a lady from the music hub, this week we put together everything we have learnt so far in preparation to do a small performance next week. In French, the children have continued to learn the colours. In PE, we have continued with our country dancing and games. The children are enjoying working with a partner to perform different dance steps such as a 'do-si-do'.
