In maths this week, we have started to look at statistics and using frequency and tally charts to interpret data. This also links in really well with our computing learning, where the children have created their own branching databases online!

In geography, the children were able to use more computing skills by researching where the different toppings of a pizza come from, some children were able to find out the food miles for each topping and a few were able to tell me whether or not importing food was a good thing, and why.
