Ruby Class Newsletter

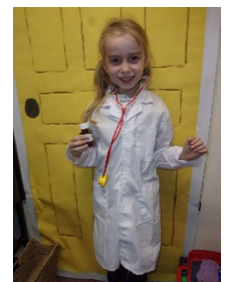
