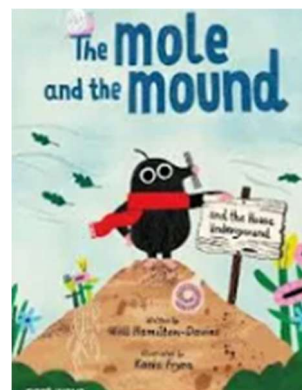


Ruby Class News

During his visit, the children had the chance to hear him read his new book as well as providing us with an art workshop. The children learnt to draw some of the characters from his new book.



The last 2 weeks of learning:

In **English**, we have been learning the twisted fairytale of Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion. We have acted out the story, carried out a character analysis of both of the main characters then the children wrote a character description on the very hungry lion. In **Maths**, we have completed our measurement investigations and the children have started to learn about division, through sharing. The children have understood this concept really well and we will continue to develop this next week. In **History**, we have also been learning about queens, comparing Queen Elizabeth II to Queen Victoria. Our **Music** lessons have also started. The children have been learning songs, and we have introduced glockenspiels this week. In **PE**, we have been practising for sports day. The children have been allocated races and all shall be participating in 3 races each as well as competing in the throwing events.
