

Ruby Class Newsletter

We have had a busy week in Ruby Class this week!

The children have been enjoying learning the Year 2 Christmas song - Go Tell it On the Mountain, ready to video and share.

We have also been learning about the festival of colours - Holi, and linked this in with our English, where the children became reporters and wrote a newspaper report all about the festival



In maths, we have continued working on our subtraction skills. We have been subracting tens and 2-digit numbers from a 2-digit number. The children have practised using lots of different ways to help them, such as part-whole models, tens and ones columns, bar models and concrete resources.



In PE (dance), we focused on clapping, stomping and hopping to the beat of the music. In RE, we thought about how people could help to raise money for charities and practised writing an email to the Tusk Trust. In computing, the children continued to work on their PowerPoint about India, they added in bullet points and facts on each slide. Next week we hope to add pictures.

In PSHE, we discussed how it might feel to have different likes and dislikes. Then we shared our own ideas about what we like and dislike.
