

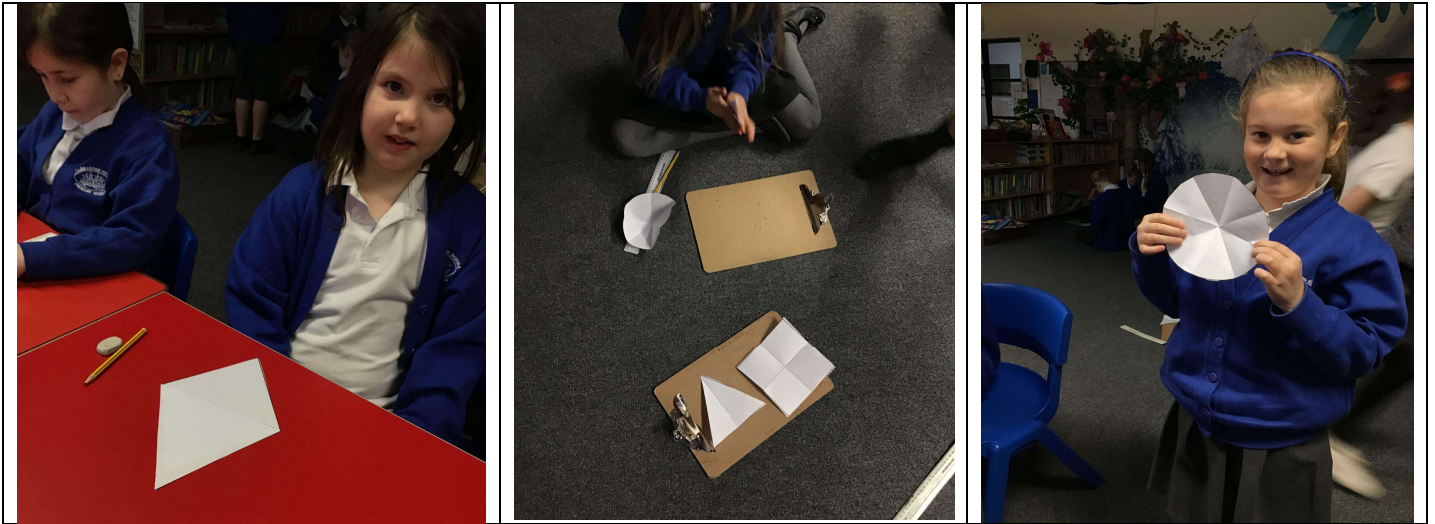

We have had an extremely busy week this week with the introduction of fractions and starting our big write in English.

On Monday, we reminded ourselves what fractions were - we looked at fractions in shapes. The children folded the shapes into equal parts and could tell me a fraction they had made. We used our mathematical language to explain what the bottom and top numbers of a fraction are called (maybe you could ask your child if they could tell you)!



In PE this week, we are carrying on with dance. The children are putting all their techniques together to come up with some really amazing dance routines! This week we incorporated jumping, along with turning and different travelling styles.



In English we have been writing up The Snow Dragon using our own characters, we have also been focussing on putting in all the literary techniques we have learnt this term! We investigated shadows in science and how they change when the light source is moved, the children loved working in the "dark". In DT we created our own switches for an electrical circuit - this will form part of our "What's in the eye" project.
