We've had a very creative week in Ruby Class this week!

In English, the children have been writing their own poetry. They have written a spring poem using their senses and an acrostic poem all about Brunel.





In our mental maths we have continued with multiplication (2x table). In our main maths we have looked at statistics. The children have used tally charts to collect data about our favourite biscuits. Then they have put the data into a bar diagram and a pictogram.



In RE, we have learnt about the Christian story of Easter. The children enjoyed thinking about new life and created a collage out of natural materials to represent new beginnings. In PSHE, we explored medicines. The children discussed how medicines work and how they must be used safely. In PE, we continued with gymnastics exploring different ways to turn our bodies using aparatus. In science, we investigated how different materials can bend, squash, twist and stretch.
