In maths, we have been learning to count in steps of 3, 4 and 8. We have used a variety of strategies to help us, such as, songs, tapping, concrete resources, number lines and sequencing. This week in science, we have explored muscles. The children made their own muscles out of cardboard and elastic bands to help them to understand how a muscle works. In music, we continued to learn songs with a lady from the music hub, this week we practised singing in the round.
