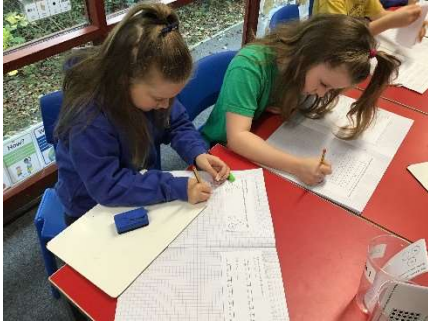

# Ruby Class Newsletter

This week in maths, we have recapped and refreshed our mental addition and subtraction, as well as focused on problem solving using both written and mental methods.



In English, we've started writing our new chapter. The children have been trying really hard to include adverbs, prepositions and creative language. We really do have some budding authors in our class!



In DT, we explored the different types of egg boxes on the market and carried out some investigations and experiments to see how strong their packaging was. In PSHE, we discussed conflict in families and friendships and looked at a 'Solve-it together' technique to help us resolve conflict should it happen. In PE, we continued with gymnastics. Our focus was making ourselves into a 'star' and 'pin' shape, then practising travelling in those shapes (cartwheels and handstands). In art, we have practised 'tone and texture' in the style of Quentin Blake. In RE, the children have continued to learn about the festival of Diwali and how it is celebrated.
