In **English** we have been using the joining word 'and' to join clauses in our sentences. In **Maths** we have been learning to count in 2's and applying this to solve simple multiplication questions. The children have seen the multiplication sign and we have talked about this meaning 'groups of'. We have been making arrays using counting resources to help us solve problems. This week in **Science** we enjoyed trying a new science quiz to test our knowledge of this terms learning about materials. We also enjoyed exploring which floating and sinking with different materials.
