



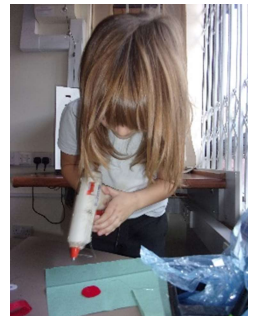
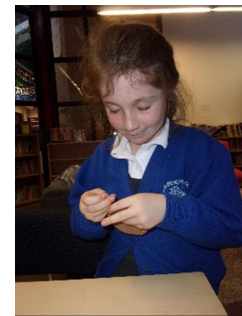
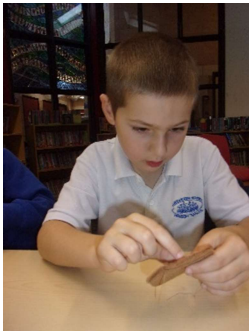
Ruby Class Newsletter
