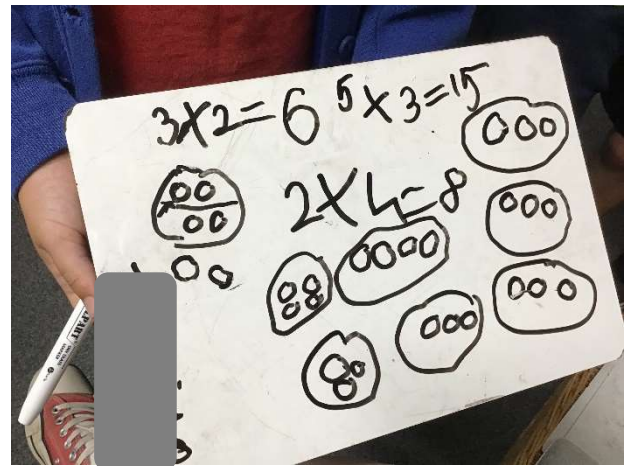
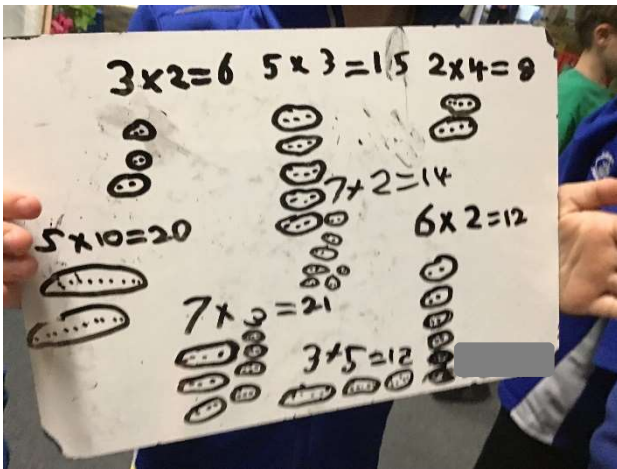


Ruby Class News
