The children have thought lots about how change starts with us. We have explored how to deal with bullying and the impact it can have on all involved. In maths, we have continued with addition and subtraction. Our focus has been looking at fact families and using the inverse to check our answers. The children have then applied their knowledge to solve problems.

In English, the children have been learning about the past and present tense and how the verb changes depending on which tense is used.

Science has seen the children exploring the importance of exercise. They have measured their heartbeat when resting and after exercise to see the change in their heart rate.
