We have had another busy week in Ruby Class!

In English, the children have been learning about different sentence types: questions, statements, commands and exclamation sentences. They have written questions to ask Mowgli about the jungle and questions to find out about elephants.



We have continued our learning in place value (maths), by applying our skills to problem solving and reasoning questions. The children have also been developing their skills in mental maths, using Top Marks.

In art, we used different art techniques: printing and rubbing. In music, our focus has continued with beat and tempo. In computing, we have finished creating the pictures for our comic strips and next week hope to type up our the sentences to match each picture. PE (dance), we built on our skills from last week to create a cat dance. In RE, we have thought about what a Good Samaritan is and how we might care for others.
