In maths, we have continued to work on fractions. We have been working on recognising, finding and writing halves, quarters and thirds. The children have shaded fractions of shapes, sorted objects into groups and calculated the fraction of an amount.

We have also looked at statistics. The children have learnt how to collect and interpret data using tally charts and pictograms.









In English, we have started to look at the story of Traction Man. We have explored the settings, characters and story plot. We have also learnt about apostrophes in contractions.

In art, we are exploring 'Pop Art' and Andy Warhol. We have looked at some of the techniques used and practised them on a repeating picture of Florence Nightingale.
