Term 5, week 2:

It was so wonderful to see everyone last week for our postponed parents evening. Thank you for your adaptability. We are now entering the summer term and term 5 already seems to be flying by. It feels like only yesterday that I was stood in front of all of your lovely children in September and now we will start considering moving the children on to year 2. Luckily, we still have lots of learning and fun to have between now and then.

The last 2 weeks of learning:

In **English**, we have learnt about commands, and this has developed into writing instructions on how to make a jam sandwich. The children were fantastic at identifying next steps and they recognised that the instructions all started with verbs (imperative). We then improved on this by adding time adverbials (later, after, then, etc.) In **Maths**, we have finished our multiplication learning, and we have been delving into the world of measurement. The children have been making predictions on weight and length. We will continue with this next week, adding capacity to our predictions. This week, we have had our project Wow Day which launched our new project, focusing on twisted fairy tales. Thank you so much for all your efforts to dress the children up for our day. They loved it and our little bird breads seem to turn out well. The children enjoyed eating them.
