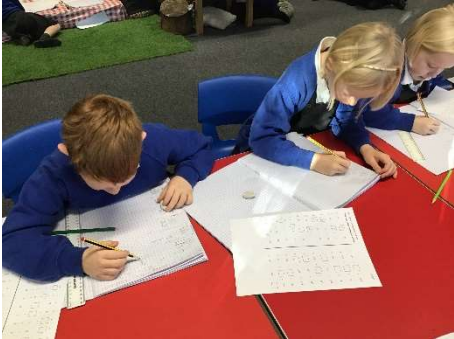

In maths, we have concluded our learning in addition and subtraction with answering missing number and word problems. Next week we will be moving on to exploring shape and angles.



In English, we have started a new focus on poetry. We have looked at some new grammar skills to help us in the form of alliteration, rhyme and rhyming couplets. We also thought about how poetry can be performed to gain the listener/readers interest.
