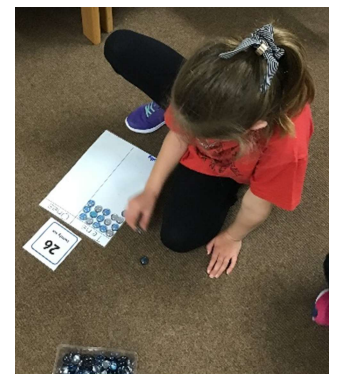
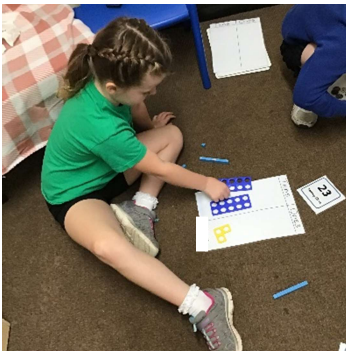




# Ruby Class Newsletter

In maths, we have been working on identifying and representing numbers. The children have practised partitioning 2-digit numbers into tens and ones, understanding the place value of a number and finding alternative ways to represent this new knowledge in a number sentence.
