This week has been a big challenge for lots of the children, introducing time and learning how to sew. However all the children have taken it in their stride and I am proud of them all.

In maths we have started to look at time and recapping what we already know. We then went on to use our knowledge to answer questions using the vocabulary of time.

In English we have started to write our own version of Stone Age Boy, all the children have come up with some really creative changes and made sure they have included lots of literary techniques they have learned across Year 3.

Another week means another scientific experiment. The children already knew lots about magnets attracting and repelling. But this week, they confirmed their hypothesis by noticing what happens when you try and attract 2 of the same poles.



During PE, the children were using their athletic skills through running, and target skills through throwing and catching to work as a team to see how many times they could take 5 bean bags from one hoop to another. They then made the distance further - some groups even did the whole length of the netball court!



On Tuesday afternoon, the children practiced a running stitch. For some children, this was the first time doing sewing. They all amazed me with their perseverance and determination. Some children even completed 3 lines worth of running stitch!

As we are looking at the Stone Age this term, during history, the children got to explore a box from Yate Heritage Centre that had lots of artefacts from the Stone Age. The children were all really excited to look at these and had lots of questions.
