I will tell someone if I am hungry or thirsty

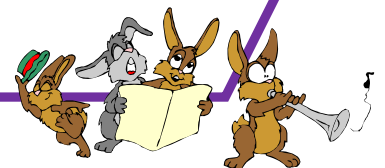

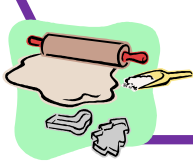
