

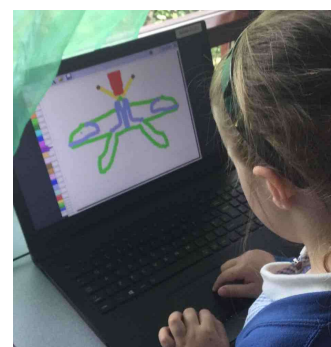
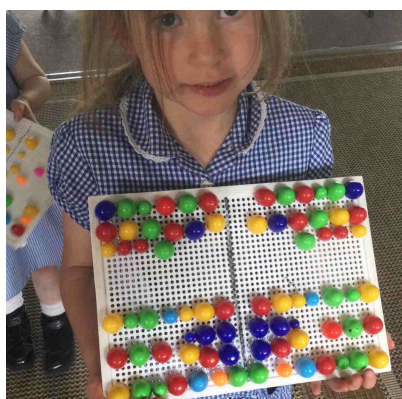
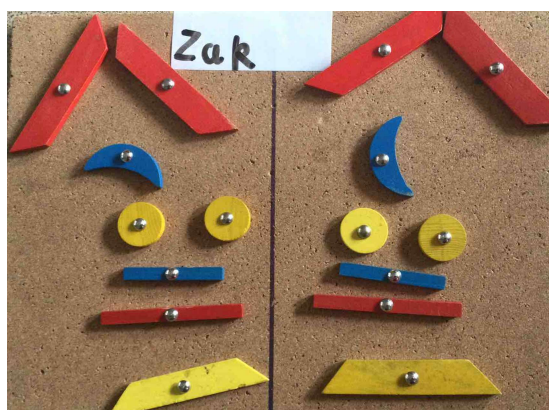
Topaz News
