

# Topaz News



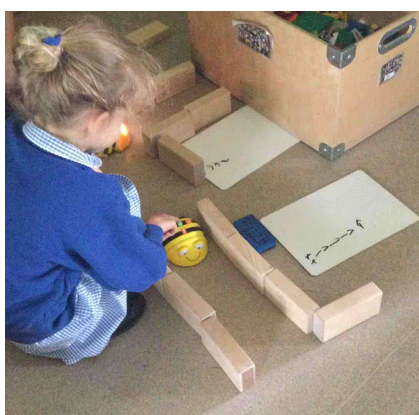
This week we have been consolidating our understanding of numbers up to 10.
