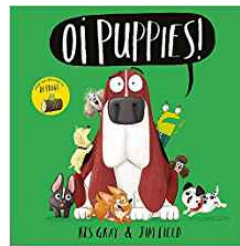
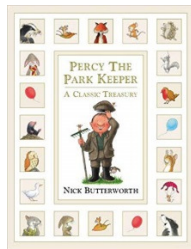
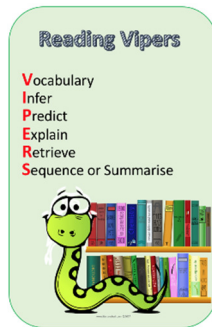




# Topaz News
