All primary schools are required to adopt a systematic synthetic phonics (SSP) program. It does have different actions for the letters than Jolly Phonics and as soon as we can we will share these with you. The children have started to look at them and are learning fast. We have enjoyed the challenge for our brains!

As soon as I can work out how to share the new resources with you, I will send them across to you. I have been explaining to the children that they can use either action until our brains switch over. It is, however, important for us to learn in the new way because we will be using this program throughout the school.

I plan to use Thursday afternoons to look at reading in the next few weeks so I can't wait to hear them all fluently showing off their practise for the week.
