In **English** we have been continuing to work on our transcription skills which holds a process of 'holding', planning, writing and revising a sentence. In **Maths** we have been learning subtracting numbers within 10, looking at the range of vocabulary that can be used for this, including fewer than, less than, subtract, take away, numbers before etc. Today, the children will be reasoning and problem-solving with the supply teacher. In **Science**, we went on a 'senses walk' around the school and writing about how we use our senses to interpret the world. In **Geography**, we have compared Bristol, Yate and Wickwar, using maps and aerial photos.
