



This Week

We have been looking at the story of The Little Red Hen. We used a story map to retell the story and the children did some fantastic acting of the story too!

We have continued to learn a new phoneme each day in phonics, please continue to practise recognising these at home. You could also practise blending by putting 3 phoneme flashcards together and seeing if your child can recognise the 3 sounds then blend them to read the word.

In maths, our number of the week was the number 2. We have represented it in different ways on our '2 table', practised recognising the numeral, thought about pairs and explored the different ways 2 can be made (0+2, 1+1, 2+0). You could support at home by spotting the numeral in the environment or noticing when there are 2 of something.
