This week we read a story called the Leaf Thief. The first time we read it, I only read the first half of the story so the children didn't find out who the leaf thief was. They got excited making predictions about who they thought it was and why. There were some amazing ideas. The next day, we read to the end of the story and found out that the real thief was the wind! We have also introduced the Beebots, programmable robots that look like bees. We have used directional vocabulary to explain where they have travelled. Some children even made roads for them to travel along. In maths, we have focused on the number 3, recognising when there are 3 in a set. We are looking forward to welcoming you to our journal share next Wednesday at 3pm.
