## Phonics and reading and numbers

Phonics This week we have introduced the sounds th/ng/oo/ee

I will be posting a video to explain the action on Evidence Me over the weekend but there is a link there to keep you going.

In maths we have been practising recalling parts of 5. We have been practising the finding the different parts and using phrase like 3 and 2 makes 5, 4 and 1 makes 5 etc.

You can practise this at home. Keep number recognition fresh by looking at it often and get your child to count things making sure they carefully match their finger to one thing at a time as they count.
