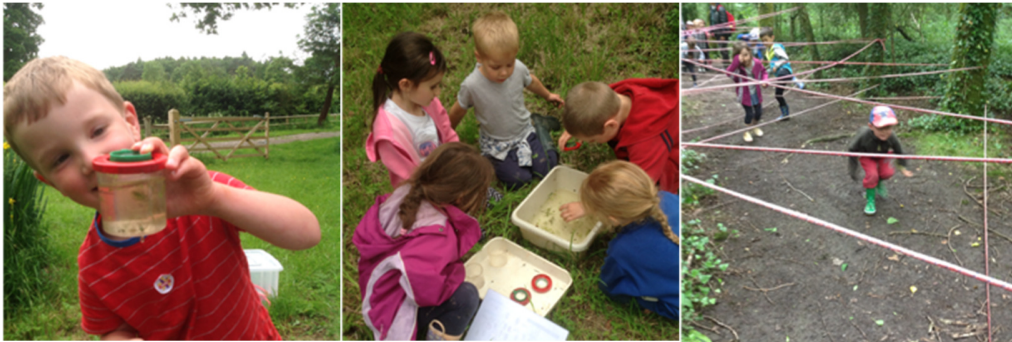


Topaz News
