At Alexander Hosea we talk to the children about growing as learners and how tricky things helps their brains to grow inside. Research suggests that children knowing themselves as



learners will help them to be the best learner that they can be for now and in the future. We have started with stick-ability (resilience). Sammy our tortoise has been reminding us that it is good to finish one thing before you move onto the next even if it gets tricky on the way.

At home you can support this by encouraging your child to keep trying when they find something tricky. It might be taking their jumper off or doing up their coat.

On the way home ask them when they have needed to use their stick-ability. If they say they found something tricky remind them that it will be good for their brain.

We also talk about problem solving being good for us and things not always being right the first time is great for us when we are learning.



We have a comprehensive PHSE (Personal, Health and Social Education) scheme that runs through the school. We run regular sessions through the week. Each session has a mindful moment when we teach breathing techniques to develop self-regulation. We then have a topic for discussion. This week we have been talking about kind hands and how we can make other people feel with our actions and words.
