Encouraging use of different voices in re-telling will help us when we are reading. Through watching their role play we can also see if they are able to sequence the stories and whether they are using some of the newly introduced vocabulary. We have talked about the lush green grass, the ravenous and furious troll, the wolf slinking through the forest. We have also talked about what a stream is through our practising. It has also been lots and lots of fun! This will continue next week. At home you could make some puppets and re-tell a story.



In maths we have revisited the odd tops and even blocks.

Lots more re-telling of stories! We will add the three bears next week -	-Practise recalling doubles using the sentence eg. 4 is made from 2 and 2. Double 2 is 4. Practise to double 5. Read 5 times a week with the phonic book. Remember to build fluency and if there is a question mark or exclamation mark we have been using expression. You can model this and then they can read back
