Also in September we purchased **book** bags for all our new reception children.

Who are "The Friends"?

Apologies to those who already know who we are and what we do, but for those who don't, please read on!

The Friends are typically a group of parents (though grandparents, carers and anyone else who has an interest in the school is welcome), who work with teachers to raise extra funds for our children and the school. Over the years the money we have raised has helped to purchase a variety of resources and experiences for the children of our school.

We arrange a variety of events throughout the year so there should be something for everyone. We also provide small fun things for the children such as crackers for their Christmas meal and hot chocolate and biscuits for the





school's Bedtime Stories event.

As well as our own section on the school website, we have a Facebook page which is kept updated with details of events and meetings, so please take a look!
